DAY 1 - U.S.A.-TAIPEI
Today Depart from LAX to Taipei.

DAY 2 - Arrival TAIPEI
Upon arrival at Taoyuan International Airport (TPE), you will be met and transferred to your hotel by private car (NO guide). The remainder of the day will be free.
Hotel: A. Regent Taipei or Palais de Chine Hotel or Marriott Taipei (5*)

DAY 3 - HALF DAY TAIPEI CITY TOUR (B)
Visit Chiang Kai-shek Memorial Hall, a landmark honoring the former president, followed by a photo

stop at the historic Grand Hotel Taipei. On the way, you will pass the Presidential Office Building, another iconic Taipei landmark. Next, watch the guard changing ceremony at Martyrs' Shrine, before ending the tour at the National Palace Museum, home to nearly 700,000 treasures spanning 8,000 years of Chinese history and art.

DAY 4 - TAIPEI-SUN MOON LAKE (B)
Depart from Taipei and travel to Sun Moon Lake, Taiwan's largest freshwater lake, named for its sun-shaped east side and crescent-moon west side. The area is also home to the Thao people and is famous for its stunning scenery and indigenous culture. After lunch, explore key attractions around the lake, including Ita Thao Village, Ci'en Pagoda, Xuanzang Temple, and Wenwu Temple, each offering unique cultural and historical insights. Tonight, enjoy a comfortable stay at a 5-star hotel in either Sun Moon Lake or Taichung.
Hotel: Fleur de Chine Hotel – Mountain View Room (5-star) /Le Meridien Taichung (5-star)/ a similar

DAY 5 - SUN MOON LAKE -TAINAN- KAOHSIUNG(B)
Start the second day with breakfast before heading to Tainan, Taiwan's oldest city known





for its rich history. Visit Fort Zeelandia, built by the Dutch East India Company, then stroll through Anping Old Street, famous for its historic charm and local snacks like tofu pudding and shrimp rolls. After lunch, travel to Kaohsiung, the largest city in southern Taiwan, and visit Fo Guang Shan Monastery, home to a magnificent 36-meter golden Amitabha Buddha surrounded by hundreds of smaller statues.

Tonight, stay at a conveniently located 5-star hotel, close to shops and convenience stores, perfect for preparing for the rest of your Taiwan journey.r.

DAY 6 - KAOHSIUNG-KENTING-TAITUNG (B)

After breakfast, travel south to Kenting National Park, Taiwan's first national park, known for its dramatic coastal geology, tropical scenery, and rich marine life. Visit highlights including Maopitou, Chuanfan Rock, Eluanpi Lighthouse, and Longpan Park, each offering unique natural landscapes and stunning ocean views. After exploring Kenting, continue along the scenic South Link Highway to Taitung. Tonight, relax at a hot spring resort in Zhiben, famous for its carbonate hot springs known to help improve circulation and relieve fatigue.

DAY 7 - TAITUNG-EAST COAST NATIONAL SCENIC AREA-YILAN (B)

After breakfast, continue your journey along Taiwan's east coast, one of the island's most



pristine and scenic regions. Along the way, visit several spectacular coastal sites including Xiaoyeliu, Sanxiantai, Shitiping, and Fanshuliao, each known for its unique geological formations shaped by wind, waves, and time.

Highlights include the fascinating rock formations of Xiaoyeliu, the iconic bridge and offshore island at Sanxiantai, the wave-carved coastal terraces of Shitiping, and the canyon landscape of Fanshuliao, often compared to a smaller Taroko Gorge.

Tonight, stay in Jiaoxi, Yilan, a town famous for its relaxing hot springs.

DAY 8 - Yilan - Taipei

Depart from Yilan in the morning and visit your first highlight, the Kavalan Distillery in Yuanshan Township, Taiwan's premier whisky producer known for its award-winning single malts. Next, visit the National Center for Traditional Arts, where you can explore Taiwan's rich cultural heritage, watch skilled artisans at work, and discover traditional crafts such as wood carving, paper cutting, and pottery. Subsequently, you'll return to Taipei and reach your hotel or the designated drop-off location in the evening.
